What's our purpose?

- **Young Playwrights** will develop 10 minute plays for stage. This program helps young writers work through the process of playwriting beginning with ideas, characters, conflict and dialogue, through drafts, revisions, readers theatre and stage production.
- **Young Poets** will explore poetry through Poetry Out Loud which encourages young people “ to learn about great poetry through memorization and recitation. This program helps young people master public speaking skills, build self-confidence, and learn about literary heritage and contemporary life.” (Ohio Arts Council, 2022.)
- **Young Storytellers** will develop storytelling skills through SPARK, a program that nurtures and teaches young tellers in the art of story. SPARK stands for Storytelling to Promote Acceptance, Respect and Kindness.

How often will we meet?

We will organize from 2:30-4 PM on Sunday, October 23rd at the Trinity Playhouse.

After that, we will meet 1-2 times per month according to the best time for the group and do some in-person and some ZOOM meetings.
